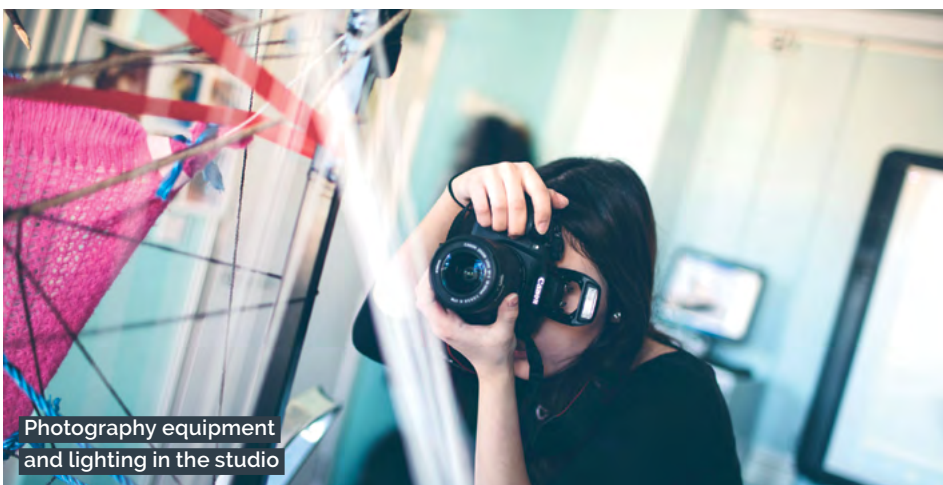

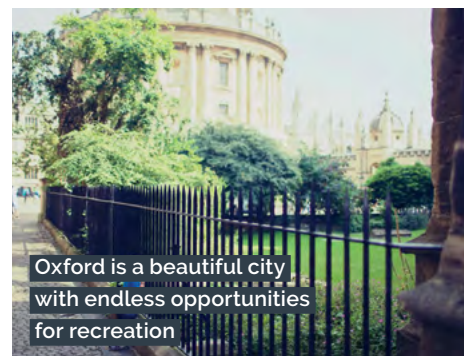

Student Residences

Wavy Gate is our year-round purpose-built premium residence featuring spacious, single, en suite bedrooms in a contemporary building. There are on-site kitchen and laundry facilities, plus full time live-in accommodation staff. A limited number of individual private "studio" apartments are also available. Wavy Gate is located in the vibrant student area of Cowley and is 15 minutes on foot (or less than ten minutes by bicycle) from St. Josephs Campus, and 25 minutes on foot from St. Michaels Campus – and from the city centre.

Homestay

Homestay is a great way to experience multi-cultural Britain and feel part of UK home life. We have a range of homestay hosts in Oxford (retired people, professional couples, single parents and families) who would all like to welcome you into their home. As a new member of the home you will take part in the normal routine of life. You will probably meet other members of the household, as well as friends and neighbours. This will be a good chance to practise your English.

Every homestay is carefully inspected by our accommodation team and checked on a regular basis to ensure they exceed the minimum requirements of our students.
